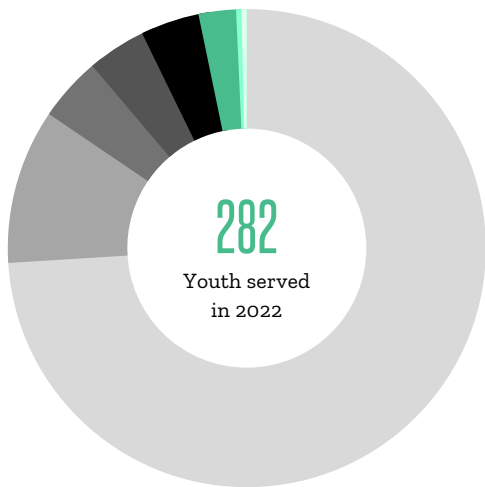
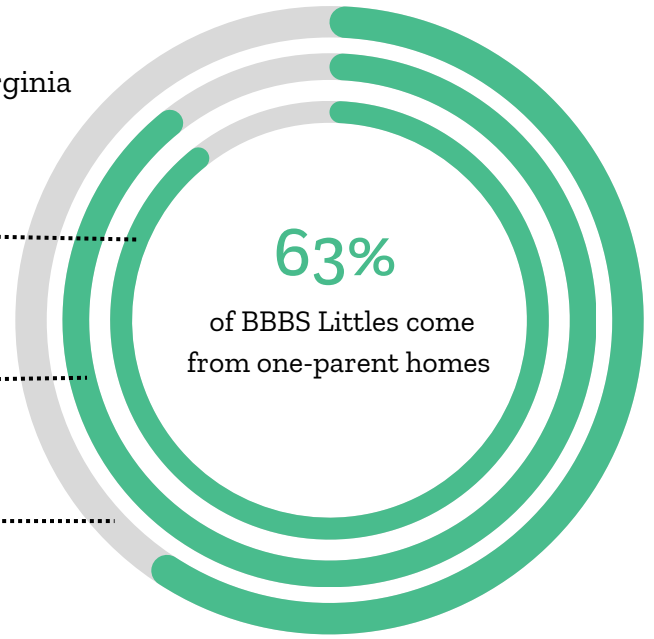

FACING ADVERSITY Approximately 30% of children in Virginia reside in one-parent homes.

80% of juvenile court cases involve children from one-parent homes

71% of high school dropouts are from one-parent homes

63% of teen suicides are from one-parent homes
